

# BOOK OF ROMANS

Romans 2:6-11

## Key Phrases

- **Deeds:** Works are not the means of salvation but they are the evidence of salvation.
- **Eternal life:** Not just quantity but an endless quality of existence.
- **Seek glory:** A desire to bring God honor and praise.
- **Seek honor:** A desire to serve.
- **Seek immortality:** An eternal perspective.
- **Wrath and indignation:** Descriptive words to describe the place called Hell.
- **Self-seeking:** A description of those who serve themselves.
- **Do not obey truth:** No desire to obey God's Word or consider God's standards.
- **Obey unrighteousness:** A reminder that you can't serve two masters.
- **Partiality:** Literally, to "receive a face," that is, to give consideration to someone simply because of position, wealth, appearance, and so forth.
