**Key Phrases**

- ✓ *Do not let sin reign:* Don't let sin \_\_\_\_\_ you.
- ✓ *Do not present your members as instruments of unrighteousness:* Don't use your body to \_\_\_\_\_.
- ✓ *Present your members as instruments of righteousness:* Use your body to \_\_\_\_\_ God.
- ✓ *You are not under law but under grace:* Your motivation for righteous living is not the law, but rather, the \_\_\_\_\_.
- ✓ *Yet you obeyed from the heart:* Reference to the \_\_\_\_\_ condition of the human heart.

**Discussion Questions**

1. Consider your life before Christ. Were there sins that controlled you? How did you obey your flesh?
2. What were ways that you used your body as a “weapon for unrighteousness” before Christ?
3. How are you using your body as a “weapon for righteousness” now?
4. What are some examples of ways people in the church have excused obedience to God since we are “not under the law but under grace?”
5. Consider verse 17. What would Paul say about the instruction to follow your heart? Why?
6. Is it possible to sin while being enslaved to righteousness? Why or why not?
7. Consider verse 19. How does lawlessness lead to more lawlessness?
8. In what ways have you experienced greater conviction as you have grown in your walk with the Lord?

9. How might we apply these verses in a way that continues to grow our “fruit to holiness?”
